Purses, jewelry and other valuables should not be left unattended in the dressing room or lobby. The Studio is not responsible for loss or theft of personal items.

For Safety, dancers should wear street clothes to and from the studio.

Class Make Ups

Please notify the office when student is unable to attend classes. Makeups must be scheduled and approved.

Dropping Classes

You must notify the studio via email to drop a class; you will be responsible for any tuition/fees until notification has been received.

Class Etiquette

Consistency and punctuality complement and enhance the overall learning experience. Absenteeism limits progressing to the next level.

Any electronic watches or phones that are worn or brought into the classroom must be in a non-cellular or airplane mode. Devices used for medical reasons are exceptions.

LOBBY RULES

To be in compliance with building regulations and for the safety of our students, staff and parents the following policies must be enforced:

- Stairs and hallways must be kept clear at all times.
- No sitting or playing on any stairs
- Lobby area must be kept quiet during class times
- No running, roughhousing allowed
- No tapping or knocking on viewing windows
- Earphones must be used to listen to music or play video games
- Siblings are not allowed in the dressing room, office area or studios.
- Children must not be left unattended
- Do not move or remove furniture from the area
