**Auto Pay (or can make special arrangement)**

**NO TUITION REFUNDS - NO CREDITS NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**Family Discount** Higher tuition pays the full amount; others from the same family receive a 15% discount.

**Late Charge** Accounts more than 15 calendar days past due will be assessed a \$10 late charge.

**Returned Checks** \$35 charge for all returned checks/insufficient funds.

Please notify the office when student is unable to attend classes. Makeups must be scheduled and approved.

**Dropping Classes**

You must notify the studio via email to drop a class; you will be responsible for any tuition/fees until notification has been received.

**Class Etiquette**

Consistency and punctuality complement and enhance the overall learning experience. Absenteeism limits progressing to the next level.

Any electronic watches or phones that are worn or brought into the classroom must be in a non-cellular or airplane mode. Devices used for medical reasons are exceptions.

**LOBBY RULES**

To be in compliance with building regulations and for the safety of our students, staff and parents the following policies must be enforced:

- Stairs and hallways must be kept clear at all times
- No sitting or playing on any stairs
- Lobby area must be kept quiet during class times
